Music Policy

Only the approved DJs listed below are permitted to play aboard the Grand Lady and utilize our internal on-board speaker system if they choose to.

All DJs must keep volume to a level to which our Captain and Crew can effectively communicate in any potential emergency situations. Before guest boarding, the Captain will conduct a sound check with the DJ to set this volume level for the remainder of the event. If already playing music during boarding, the Captain will coordinate with the DJ to stop playing briefly prior to boat's departure so our crew can play our recorded safety announcement. While we are not in the business of censoring anyone's fun, we do take our image in the Buffalo maritime community seriously. We ask that songs with excessive profanity and vulgarity not be played. All music must be stopped when the vessel passes Buffalo RiverWorks on our return trip so Captain and Crew can effectively communicate during docking.
